

Hello Broadfielders!! Whilst you're at home, try hard to keep looking at the clock and learning the time. Get your parents to test you on quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) past and half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) past and  $\frac{1}{4}$  to each hour. In your books use something round ( maybe a lid of a jar) and draw 6 clocks. Add your numbers, remember how we did them in class (first, put in number 12, then 6, then 3 then 9 then fill the rest in). Now use these clocks to show the following times (remember that the hour hand is the shortest and the minute hand is the longest)

Use the picture below to see where the PAST part of the clock is and where the TO part is.



Now draw these times on your clocks! Good luck!!
