Read the poem and make a list of the words that rhyme.

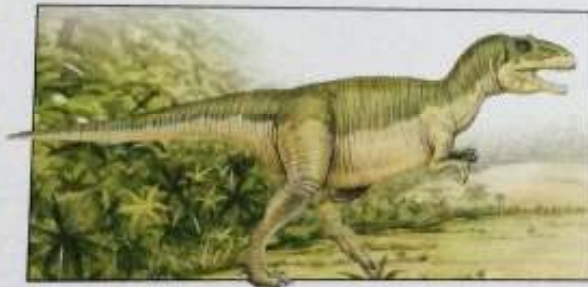
Then write the next lines of the poem.

Coelophysis

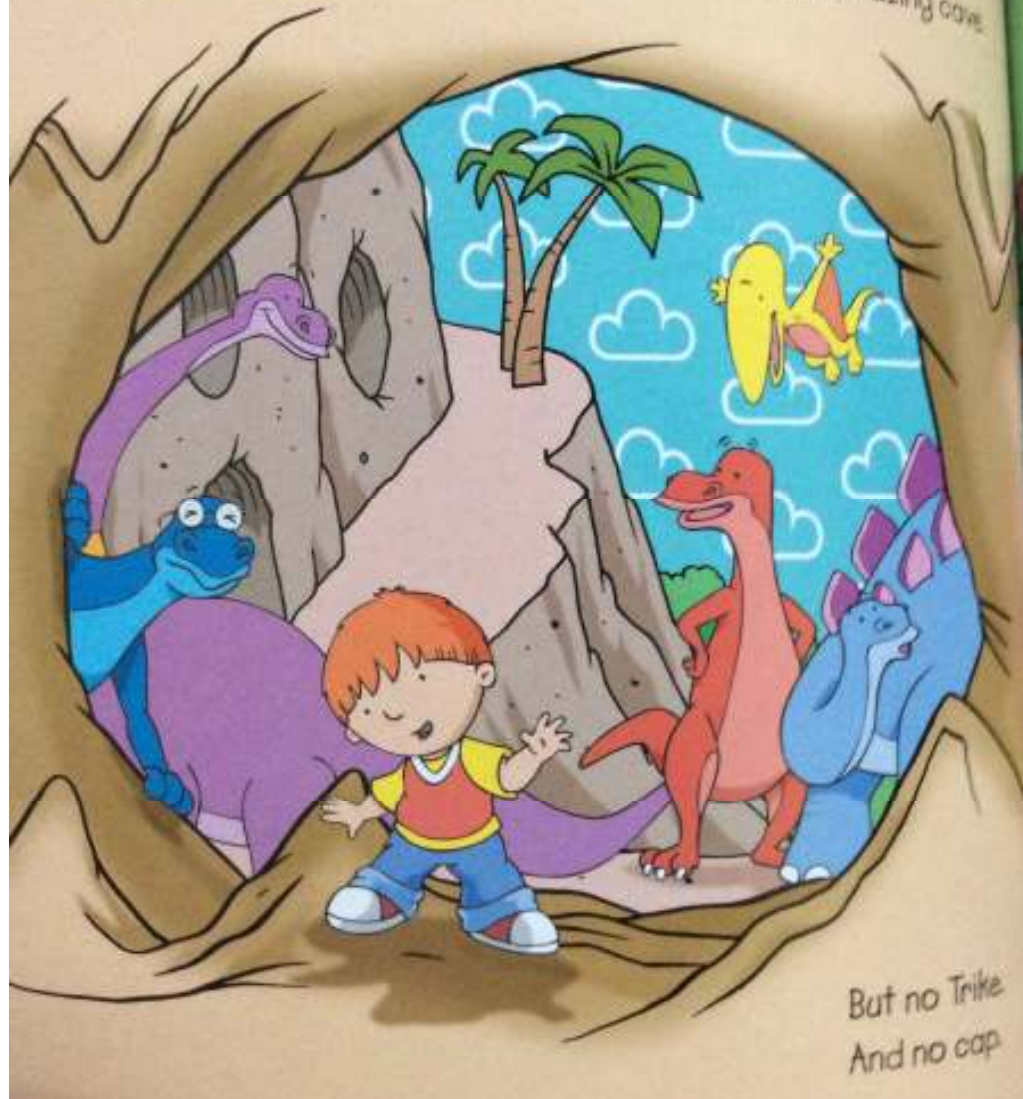


Giganotosaurus

They went to Pepper Rock and there was an amazing cave

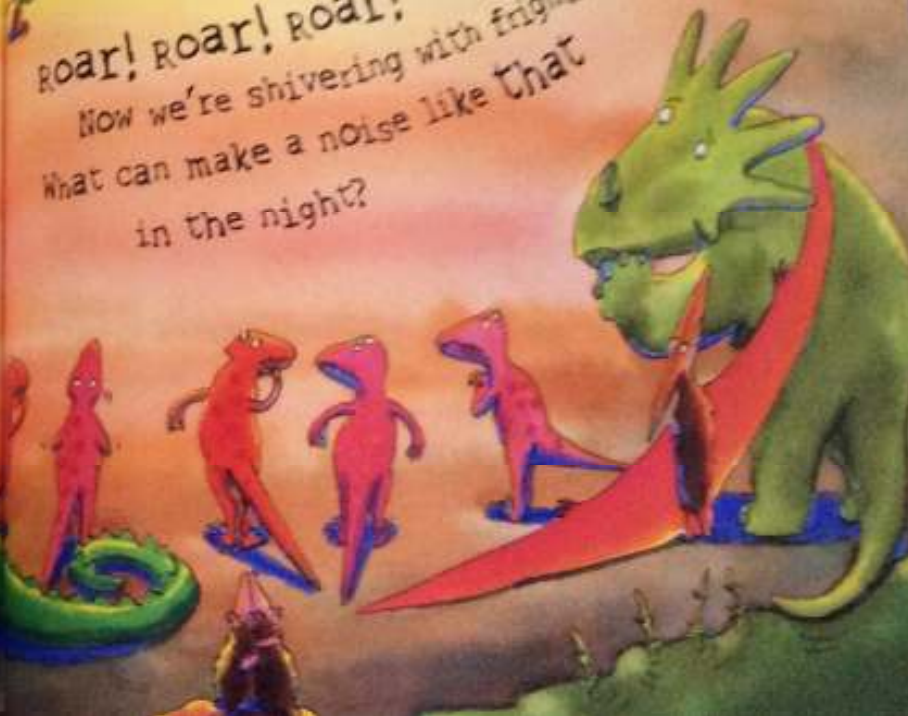


But no Trike
