- 2)** I buy a pack of pencils for £1 and a notebook for £1.50. How much have I spent altogether?

- 3)** Mr Worsley buys two ice creams for 70p each and a packet of crisps for 50p. How much has he spent altogether?

- 4)** Mr Healey bought a bike for £39.98 and a scooter for £9.78. How much money has Mr Healey spent altogether?

- 5)** I bought two pairs of socks at £2.21 each. I also bought three bunches of flowers priced £4.70 each. What was the total amount I spent?

- 6)** Mr Worsley bought two jumpers priced at £15.60 each. He also bought four lollipops which cost 30p each. How much has Mr Worsley spent?
