This week we are going to revisit Roman Numerals. Remember to read the questions carefully, what is it asking you to do?

Write these Roman Numerals in numbers

For example: CXLVII = 147 (C = 100, XL = 40, V + I + I = 7) (100 + 40 + 7 = 147)

- 1) CDIX 2) DCCCLX 3) CCXXVIII 4) CCCXCII

Write these numbers in Roman Numerals

For example: 322 = CCCXXII (C = 100, C+C+C = 100 + 100 + 100 = 300, X = 10, X + X = 10 + 10 = 20, I = 1, I + I = 2)

- 1) 995 2) 503 3) 264 4) 649

Change the dates of the following monarchs' reign dates to numbers

For example:

William I MLXVI to MLXXXVII = 1066 to 1087 (M = 1000, LX = 60, VI = 6) (M = 1000, L = 50 + XXX = 30, VII = 7)

2) Edward I MCCLXXII to MCCCVII
3) Henry V MCDXIII to MCDXXII
4) Henry VIII MDIX to MDXLVII
5) Elizabeth I MDLVIII to MDCIII
6) Victoria I MDCCCXXXVII to MCMI
