
Thursday - Writing

10. When he reached the second doorway, Carter felt around it to see how it would open.




What can you see?
Wonderful things!




In the corner, behind the animal shaped couch, there was another sealed door that led to a smaller room.

16. At last they were ready to open the door!




17. They saw a wall of pure gold – the first of four shrines, each bigger than the one inside it.
