Post-16	Oldham?

Growing up during lockdown is a unique experience, and we want to capture and learn from our young people. Our Youth Council will review submissions and look at how we use this to build for the future.

Students are invited to submit a digital single A4 page (max 400 words) of any style of creative writing (poetry, story, song) which will be stored in Oldham Gallery's <u>Lockdown Museum</u>. Each school should select 5 commended pieces to be considered in the competition final.
