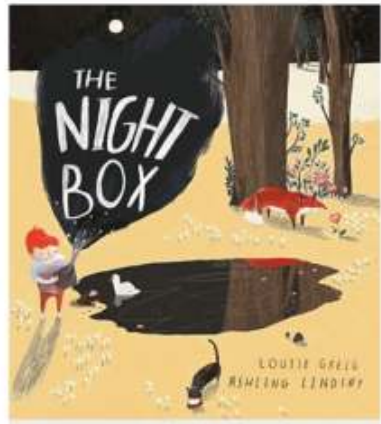


Click on the link below and listen to the story 'The NIGHT BOX'

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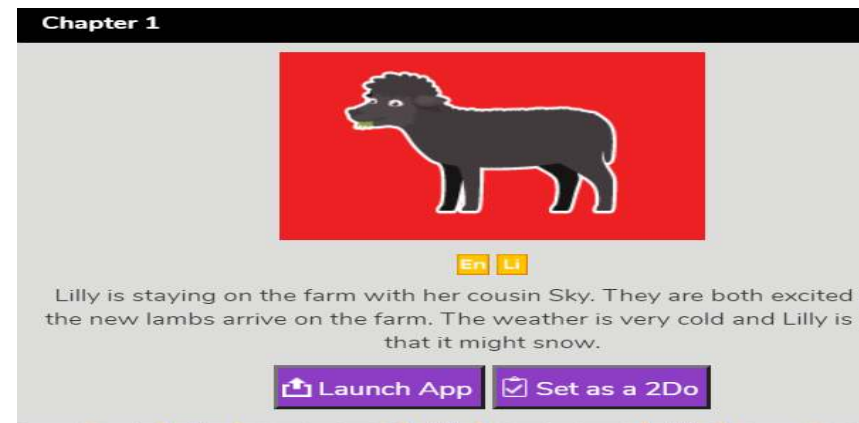
