Try to complete some of these tasks whilst at home. You can also make up a new task of your own to share with the class when we return to school.

Choose your favorite animal in the whole wide world and make a fact file about it and let me know WHY it is so great! You could make it a funny pet like a PET ELEPHANT.....

Think about its diet (what it eats) is it a herbivore? (Herbivores eat plants) a carnivore? (Carnivores eat meat) or an omnivore? (Omnivores eat plants and meat).
How long do they live?
What do they need to live a healthy and happy life?
Where do they sleep?
Why do they make good/bad pets?

Look at the picture of the ravenous beast.

Draw and write about your own ravenous beast.

Has your beast got paws, claws or whiskers?

Choose one of the animals from the pet picture and write an acrostic poem.

Think about how the animal looks, feels, lives and would eat to help you with your poem.

What other points do you remember from the video?

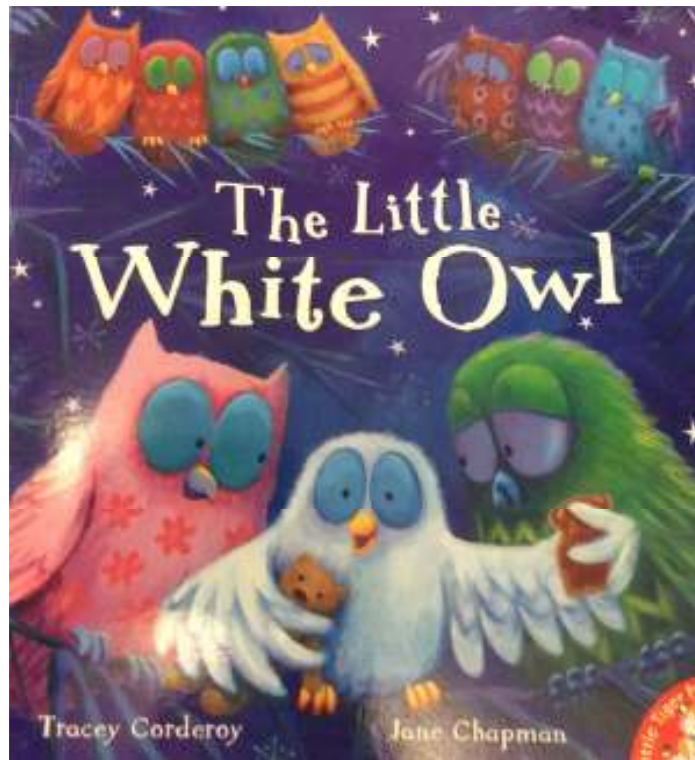
Maybe you could suggest a great name for it too?

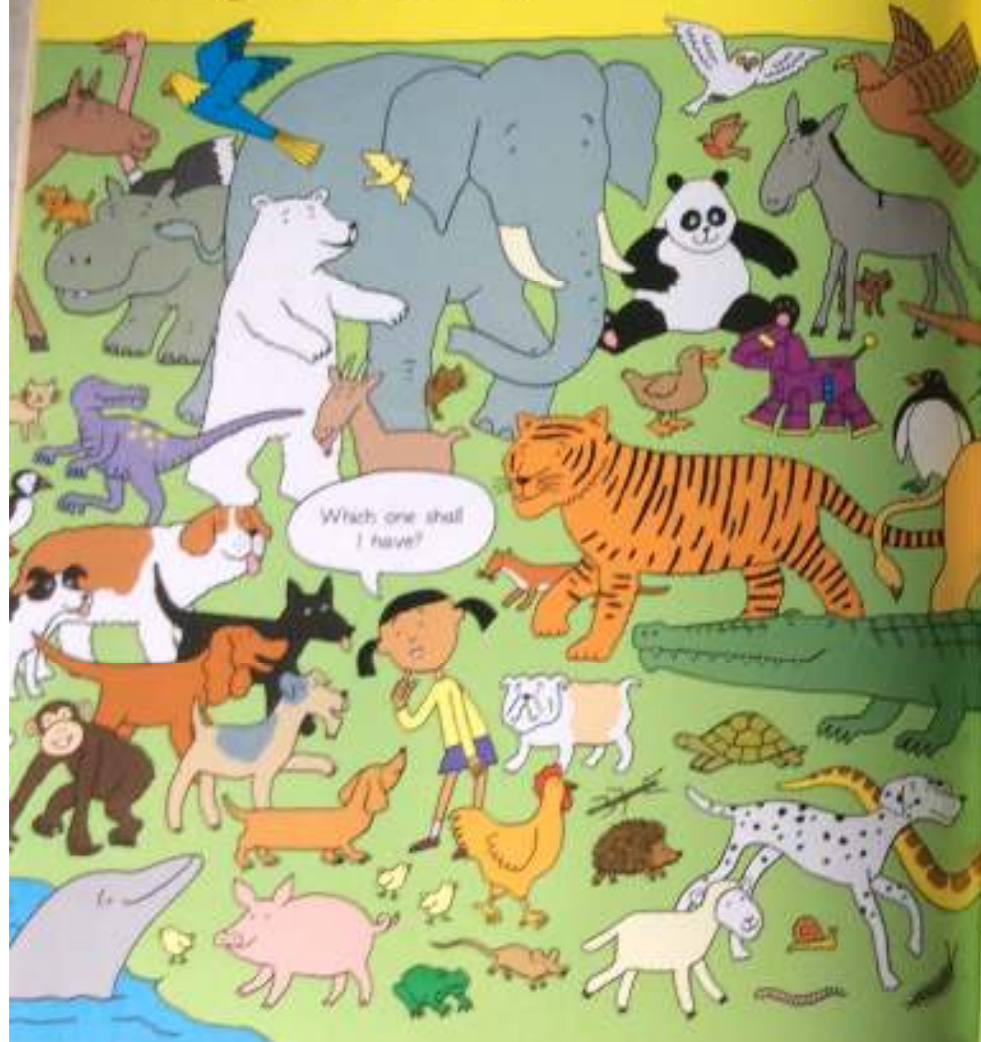
"I AM
