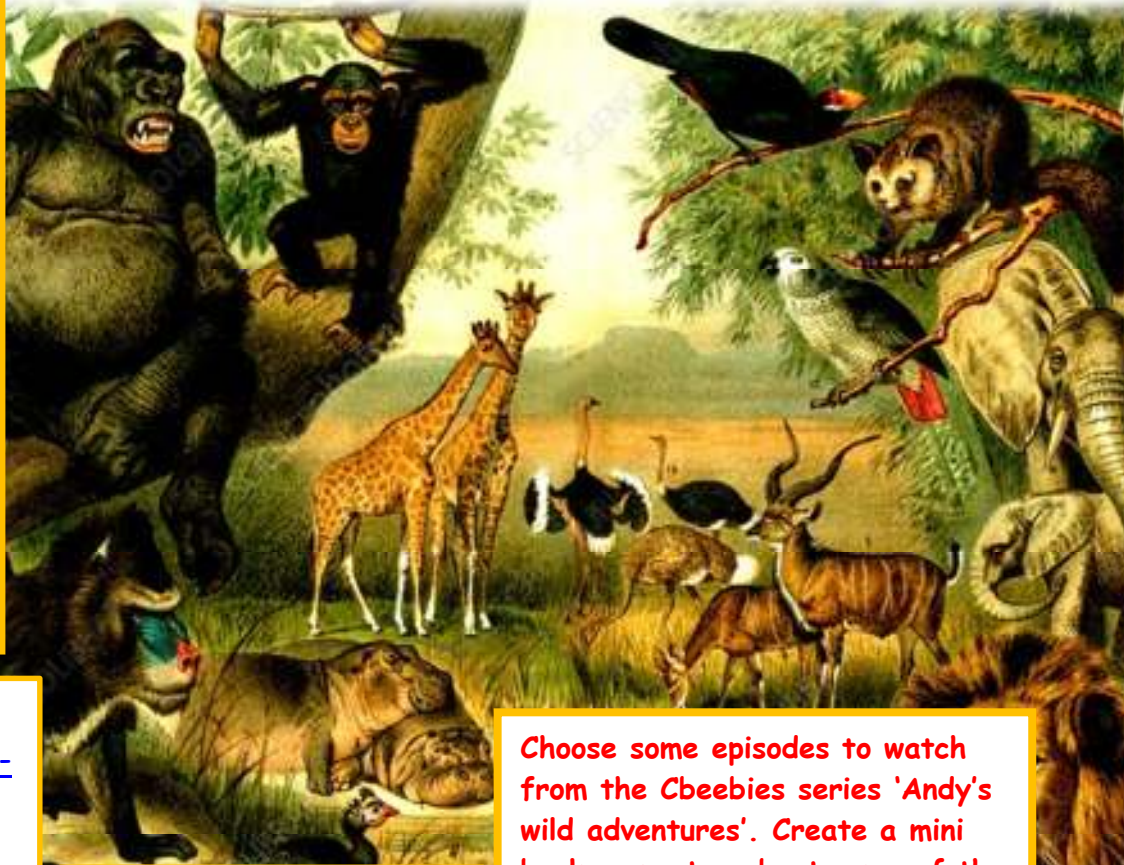


# Paws, claws & whiskers


Make some animal crafts using paper plates and materials you have at home. Look at the pictures for some ideas or think of your own!
