

Paws, claws & whiskers

Which animals have paws, claws and whiskers? Draw and write their names.

What does 'camouflage' mean? Why do animals use it?

Make a scrapbook all about your pet. If you don't have a pet, make a scrapbook about your dream pet or a pet belonging to someone you know.

What animal is your pet? What type and breed of animal is it? What is the pet's name? Describe and draw what it looks like.

Add your favourite photographs. Write down what you love about your pet.

What interesting things does your pet do? What does it need to stay healthy?

Can you write/draw an A-Z animal alphabet? E.g A is for Alligator, B is for Bengal Tiger, C is for Chimpanzee etc.

Make some animal crafts using paper plates and materials you have at home. Look at the pictures for some ideas or think of your own!




Twinkl Go instructions
