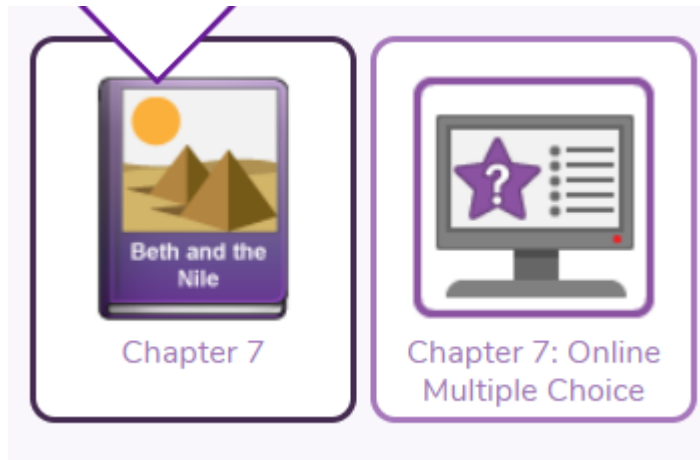
Purple Mash time!! This is the last chapter of this amazing book.
