Write about what Little Mouse found on his adventure.


What insects did he see ?

Look at the final picture.


Little Mouse was tired and he decided to go back home. Mummy mouse was waiting for him.

Write about what Little Mouse told his mummy about his adventure.



A poem By Robert Hull





Please, do not feed the ostriches sandwiches
