Badger



A badger is a large grey mammal. They can be spotted by their black and white striped face, black stomach and paws and a short, fluffy tail. They are in the same family as stoats, otters and weasels.

There are many badgers found in the UK and they are the biggest land predator with a length of 75-100cm. They can be found in England, Scotland and Wales.

Badgers are nocturnal, which means they are awake at night. They live in large family groups in a burrow known as a 'sett'. You can spot a badger sett by finding a tidy entrance, marked with piles of used bedding. Young badgers (cubs) are born in January or February and spend their first two to three months underground, coming out in spring.

Badgers are omnivores. They eat small animals, bird's eggs, a mixture of fruit and use their sharp front claws to dig for roots in the ground.

Red Fox



A red fox is a well-known mammal in the UK. They have orangey-red fur with a white underbelly and on the tip of their long bushy tail (known as the brush). They also have dark brown feet and black tips on their ears. They are in the same family as dogs.

A fox can be between 62 to 72cm long with a brush as long as 40cm. The brush is important to a fox's survival as it helps with balance, can be used as a blanket in brisk weather and can signal to other foxes.

Male foxes, known as dogs, can be heard barking but female foxes, known as vixens, make a loud howl (which can sound like a scream) as a way of talking to each other.

Foxes are omnivores: they eat small animals, birds, rats, earthworms and frogs as well as berries and fruit. They will look for food in many places, such as towns, cities and the countryside. Foxes are excellent predators but will also roam through bins for scraps of food.

Foxes have been used in many stories and are usually described as cunning and crafty.

Brown Hare



A brown hare is a small brown mammal with a pale belly and white tail. It is larger than a rabbit with longer legs and longer ears that have a black tip. They can grow to a length of 50 to 70cm and live for up to 4 years. They have been seen all over the UK as far back as Roman times.

Unlike rabbits, hares do not dig burrows (a deep hole in the ground). Instead, they prefer to live in farmland and woodland and make 'forms'. These are shallow holes in the long grass made by the hare laying on the bare earth. To protect themselves, they lie as still as a statue, camouflaged in the grass. If they are disturbed, they can be seen bounding across the fields at high speeds - sometimes up to 45mph.

They are nocturnal creatures, which means they are awake at night, so they can be difficult to notice.

Brown hares are herbivores: they graze on plants and bark of young trees and bushes.
