- Sword
- Dagger
- Javelin
- Shield







# Gladius

Click



- Main Weapon
- 50cm long
- Light
- Good for stabbing

# Pugio

- Dagger
- Worn on the belt at the left side







# Pilum



Cl



- Throwing spear
- Long weapon (2metres long)
- Made from wood and metal
- They carried two of these





# Shield



- Used to protect
- Metal Boss can be used as a weapon
- Carried on the right side

- Men and women
- Swords
- Shields
- Bare chested
- Fearsome looking







# Shield

Click



- Oval shaped
- Made from oak (wood) and animal skin
- Iron boss







# Fearsome Looking

- Bare chested
- Hair spiked up with lime
- Blue markings on body
