Temporary change to school day - Reception to Year 6

A letter was sent home with pupils on Friday with the following information.

Following the recent consultations with Governors, Unions, staff and parents we have decided to go ahead with the temporary change to the school day. Therefore, from Wednesday 6th January school will close to pupils at 12.45pm <u>on Wednesdays only.</u> Children who have a school meal will have a meal before they leave school.

In order to ensure pupils still receive the correct number of hours teaching, the start of the day will change slightly; doors will open at 8.35am and school will start at 8.45am **everyday**.

This change will enable us to keep class bubbles in place whilst giving all teachers their planning, preparation and assessment time in line with COVID 19 guidelines.

Working parents who are not able to make arrangements to collect children at 12.45pm should contact the school office <u>info@broadfield.oldham.sch.uk</u> during next week, so that we can plan how many children may need childcare at school.

The new arrangements do not apply to Acorns and Nursery – their hours will remain the same.
