



Asymptomatic cases of COVID

The self-isolation guidance for those people who test positive (LFD or PCR) for Covid while having no symptoms, has been updated.

The following information has been sent to us from Public Health:

- There is no change for those people who test positive and remain asymptomatic. They must self-isolate for 10 days, up to and including day 10, (with day 0 being the test day, they are free to leave their home and garden on day 11).
- For those people who test positive and have no symptoms but *become unwell with Covid symptoms during their self-isolation period, they must restart the 10 days from the day after they become unwell.*
